PREAMBLE

India is now the largest populated country in the world. The advantages of demographic dividend are dwindling with a rapid pace. According to Disability Statistics in India (based on the data of Census of India 2011) 2.21% of total Indian population has disability. 19% of the total disable population is facing visually diyang and 20% are having locomotion linked disability. Considering the sum of both visual and locomotors challenges in 39% of the divyang people in India, it is apt time to question and to know how is the building design and architecture profession is responding to the needs of most vulnerable section of disable people.

With the increased need to make all buildings accessible, the onus and responsibility rest with the architecture community. The current pace of transfer of knowledge from architecture faculties to students requires more sensitization and therefore, this faculty development program based on the universal design parameters will always be highly relevant and apt.

The proposed workshop will focus on clearing the doubts of the faculties, understanding the legal tools that are aimed to promote the design and construction of barrier free built infrastructure in India as well as highlight the existing status bridging the theory and practical aspects involved in the design of universal design for barrier free built environment.
