Subject: Conduct of entrance/eligibility test for Admissions to Post Graduate Programme in Architecture for the academic session 2024-2025 -reg.

Dear Sir/ Madam,

This is in continuation of Council's circular letter dated 30th June 2022 regarding conduct of PG entrance/eligibility test for admission to Post Graduate programme in Architecture.

In this regard, it is informed to all concerned that the Council of Architecture is going to soon announce conduct of PG Entrance Test at national level for admission to the Post Graduate programme in Architecture being imparted at the architectural institutions approved by the Council for the academic session 2024-2025. The date of Test and Examination brochure shall be issued in public domain shortly.

All the institutions approved by the Council are therefore requested to make appropriate arrangements for admission of students in Master of Architecture programme based on the PG Entrance Test conducted by the COA.

In case the centralised admission process for PG programme in Architecture has commenced in any State/UT, the concerned admission authority may process the admissions in the programme as per their respective processes or may also fill up seats on the basis of the PG Test conducted by the Council.

In case of any vacant seats remaining after the centralised admission process for Post graduate programmes approved by CoA, the same may be filled by the institutions at their level with candidates who have passed an examination in B.Arch. course or equivalent with at least 50 percent aggregate marks or equivalent CGPI.
